A word about U3A and its unique history

U3A originated in Toulouse France in 1973 by an energetic professor, Pierre Vellas. By the 1990s it had broadened its objectives to provide not only life-long learning, but enjoyment, friendship and fun. The UK went a few steps further and in 2009 it initiated the vU3A as a virtual university. U3A began in NZ in 1989 and there are 83 groups throughout the country.
