Back in 2012 Claire was a mother with a two year old toddler and no gardening experience. She started with the existing raised beds where she lived to grow vegetables, and from there branched into growing flowers for the house. She then moved on to Ikebana, foraging for the interesting branches and flowers to be found in the Red Zone. Claire's talent



with floral arranging then branched into



bouquets and arrangements for friends. 2020/21 saw her commit to a new project – leasing land and growing cut flowers for sale. A suitable site in Trent Street, Avonside (Red Zone) was found and half an acre was leased from the

City Council. Long rows of compost were laid out, planted and covered. Moon River Flower Farm is now a thriving business. Claire supplies to wholesalers, makes up wedding bouquets and holds ticketed pick-your-own evenings for the public.



We were very impressed with Claire's enthusiasm and drive especially with two children and a labour-intensive business.

After the meeting we went to Café Metro in Humphreys Drive for coffee and a catchup.
